Minutes

Meeting called at 7:01 PM

Chairman White reported on weekend Bicentennial events. Town-wide yard sale was hugely successful, brought in many new people to our town, and many residents have indicated they would like to do it again. Nearly 2000 vehicles went through town on Saturday during the yard sales; no incidents and every public property was left clean and neat.

Sunday's event was moved to Babcock Park in Dansville due to the deplorable conditions of the baseball field in the Larry Canute Memorial Park and the fear of liability for the players. According to Supervisor Babbitt-Henry at the Town Board meeting on July 5, the cost of doing the field properly would be about \$22,000 according to Parks people.

Dorothy Hotchkiss explained the costs associated with the upcoming Tent Revival in August. The breakfasts fell short of the amount needed for the tent which will be rented for four days.

The cost associated with the tent is \$1215.00 rental; the church will also need advertising which Diane Olson will set up for them. Church would like to have between \$500 and \$600

Judy made motion to give churches \$600 to cover tent and ads; seconded by Katherine Humphrey; all ayes – discussion followed.

Terri reported the ad for the Yard Sale in the Genesee Valley Penny Saver cost \$105.50. All agreed to pay that expense. Check issued and Judy is to send it with invoice.
