Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM

Financial Report - Springwater Bicentennial fund is \$474.28. When we add the \$150.50 - the \$150, our total will be \$474.78. We are still doing quite well! (Please forward to our members, thanks! ★ Per Terri)

Terri requested a check from Diane to pay for grill which SFD felt was damaged during use for Pancake Supper – said letter from SFD stated grill was valued at \$150

Thank you Card received by Judy from Peg VanScooter Bovee was shared.

Final Event – Judy outlined all the information she had found regarding putting on a 'Pig Roast' for the Salute to Havilah Toland

- Pig Roast involves 11 hrs and three people, plus supply of wood
- Becker's Farm can provide a whole pig 200# feed 200 people

OR

- Pork Butts one case \$85 includes 5 pork butts abt 16# each + 3 pork butts would feed 400 people – only one person to cook them at Bryant House and 5 hrs of time
- Potatoes are \$13 for 50# at C & R (would see if Louis Caskey would donate them or give us a better price)
- Coleslaw per case \$20.30 from C & R
- \$14.00 slaw dressing 1 gallon
- 6# butter for potatoes
- Rolls from Amish
- 250 per sleeve take out containers from C & R \$36.00
- 250 per box silverware and napkins \$36.00

ALL LEFTOVER ITEMS & SUPPLIES WOULD BELONG TO COMMITTEE TO BE DONATED TO CHURCH OR TAKEN HOME

Total for manpower (2 people) and supplies is \$650.00 (all cooking done at Bryant House and brought in)

Jeff Sick can only feed 150 people and is not available per conversation on 3/6/2017 as he is having shoulder surgery on 4/7/2017 – he charges \$150 per hour

Smitty's charges for side would be very expensive – they charge per hr for their work

Flaschman's charges \$150 per hr for a pig roast

Discussion followed and it was unanimously decided to use pork butts and services of John Motyka; cost of tickets will be \$8 – enough to cover expenses and pay for book with perhaps some leftovers.

Havilah passed around draft copies of his 'historical vignette' – (he renamed it) members chuckled and thought it quite interesting. Judy will scan copies and send out to Yeoman family and Chris Coriddi. Havilah hopes to have a 'read thru' prior to the fundraiser.

Discussion also continued regarding dispersal of any leftover funds once the history book is printed. Terri wants money donated to Springwater UMC for use of facilities and also to the Springwater Fire Department for their support and use of their building. Agreement of attending members will be made and final decision on dispersal before closing of bank account.
